Caring for Aurora Porcelain Slabs

Maintaining Aurora Porcelain slabs is straightforward and requires no special procedures. Their durability is rooted in a timeless formula—clay, water, and fire—enhanced by modern manufacturing techniques. This combination results in surfaces that are exceptionally resilient, long-lasting, and ideal for use across furnishing applications, flooring, wall cladding, and exterior façades.

Routine Cleaning of Aurora Porcelain Slabs

Aurora Porcelain surfaces are engineered for longevity and resistance to staining. However, for optimal results, it is always best to clean up spills before they dry.

For everyday cleaning:

- Use a soft microfiber cloth dampened with warm water and a neutral (pH-balanced) detergent.
- Gently wipe the surface to remove any residue.
- Rinse thoroughly with clean water.
- Dry completely to avoid streaks or water spots.

Deep Cleaning of Aurora Porcelain Slabs

Occasional deep cleaning may be needed to address more stubborn or residual dirt.

Before applying any cleaner to a large area of the surface, test it on a small, inconspicuous area to confirm effectiveness and compatibility.

Within each box of the tables below, detergents are listed in order of effectiveness, from the mildest and most commonly available to the strongest professional product.

Refer to the separate stain removal tables for recommended treatments based on the type of stain, and the finish of the surface (polished and glazed, soft touch, or matte).

After cleaning:

- Rinse the surface thoroughly with clean water.
- Dry the area completely to preserve the porcelain's appearance and finish.
